

**1** Color the animal with crayons, colored pencils, or colored markers. Cut out the animal.

**2** Crease in the middle.

First, fold the animal along the middle and unfold.



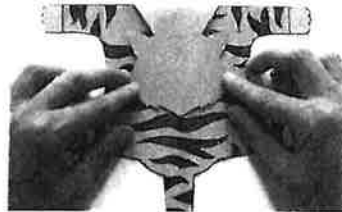
**3** Crease above the legs.

To allow the animal to stand on its legs, fold both sides near the start of the legs inwards. Unfold



**4** Crease at the neck.

Notice the kite-shaped dotted lines on the neck? Fold the neck outwards along the middle line so that it is fully bent back.



**5** Crease at the base of the head.

While keeping the neck folded, starting at the base of the head, fold the head back inward.



**6** Fold the animal in the middle.

Unfold. Fold the paper animal again along the middle like in Step 3.



**7** Fold along upper diagonal line.

While keeping the paper animal folded along the middle, fold along the dotted diagonal line closer to the head. Fold to one side.



**8** Fold same line to the other side.

Then to the other side.



**9** Fold along lower diagonal line.

Again, keeping the paper animal folded along the middle, fold along the dotted diagonal farther from the head. Likewise, fold to one side.



**10** Fold same line to the other side.



**11** Unfold.



**12** Fold the neck back.

Fold the neck outwards again



**13** Set the neck in place.

While pinching the creased triangular area in the neck, push the torso inwards along the middle.

This should cause the head to pop up slightly.



**14** Fold the head to the front.

Starting at the base of the head,

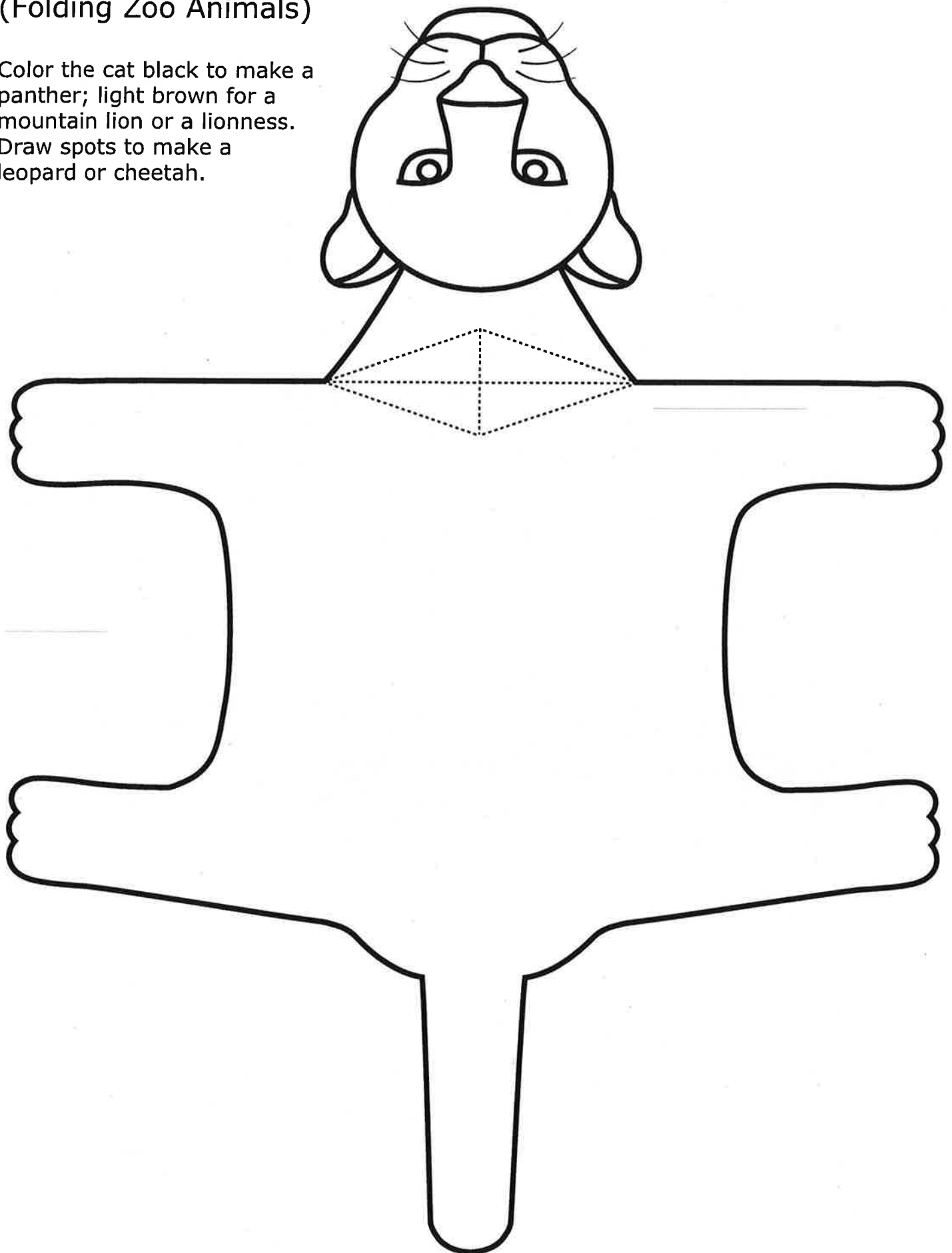
fold the head back inward



# BIG CAT

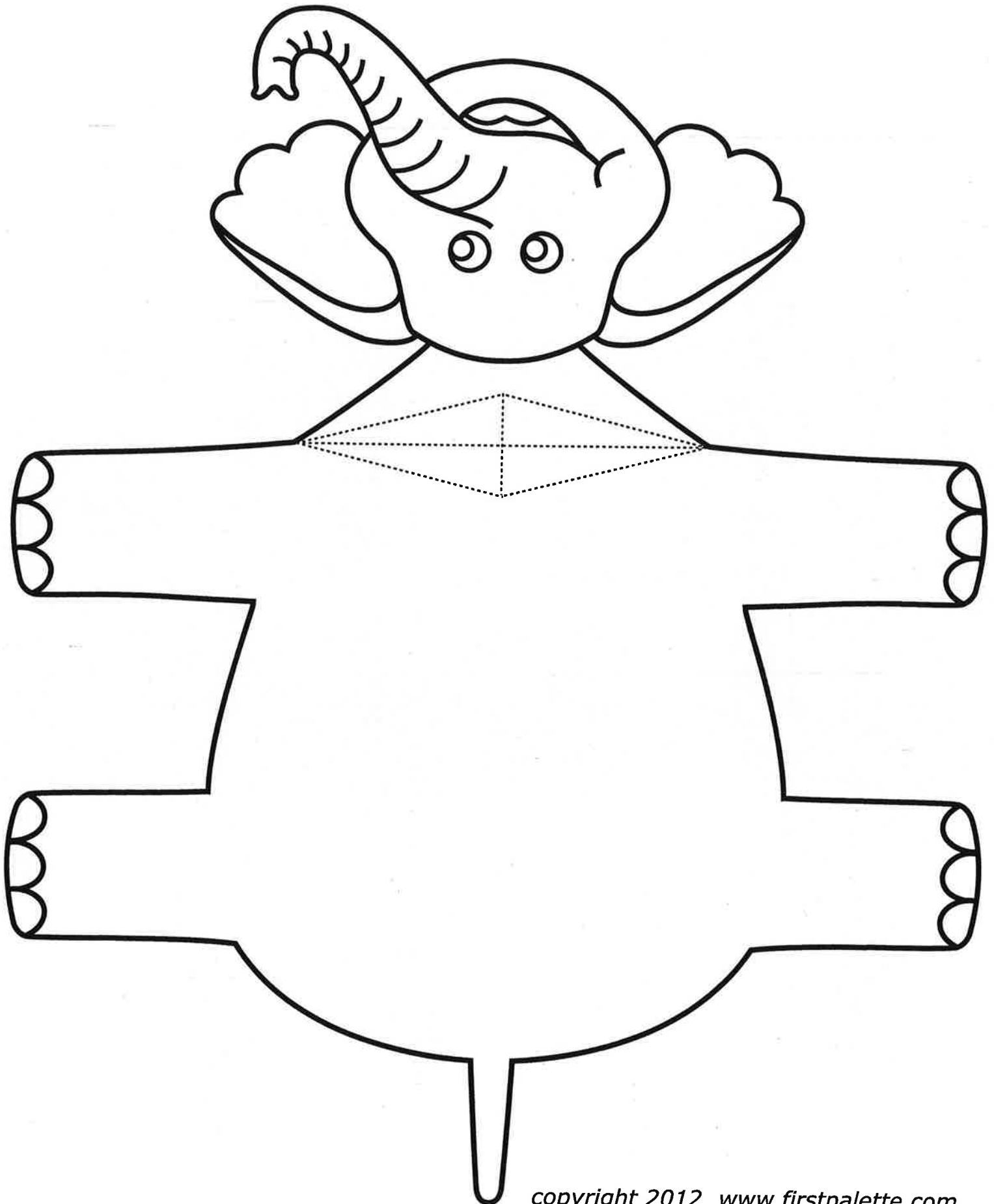

Color the cat black to make a panther; light brown for a mountain lion or a lioness. Draw spots to make a leopard or cheetah.



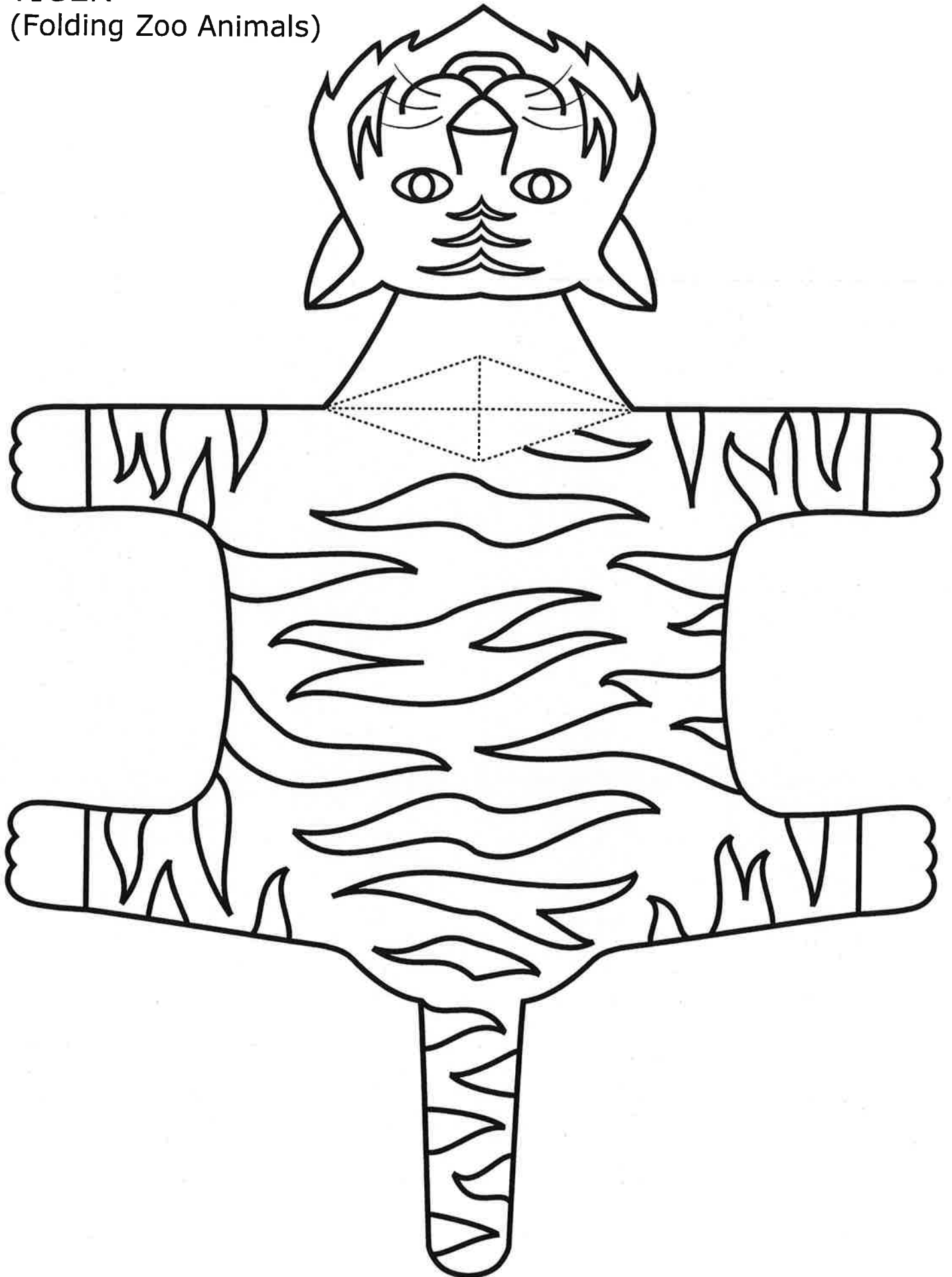


**ELEPHANT**

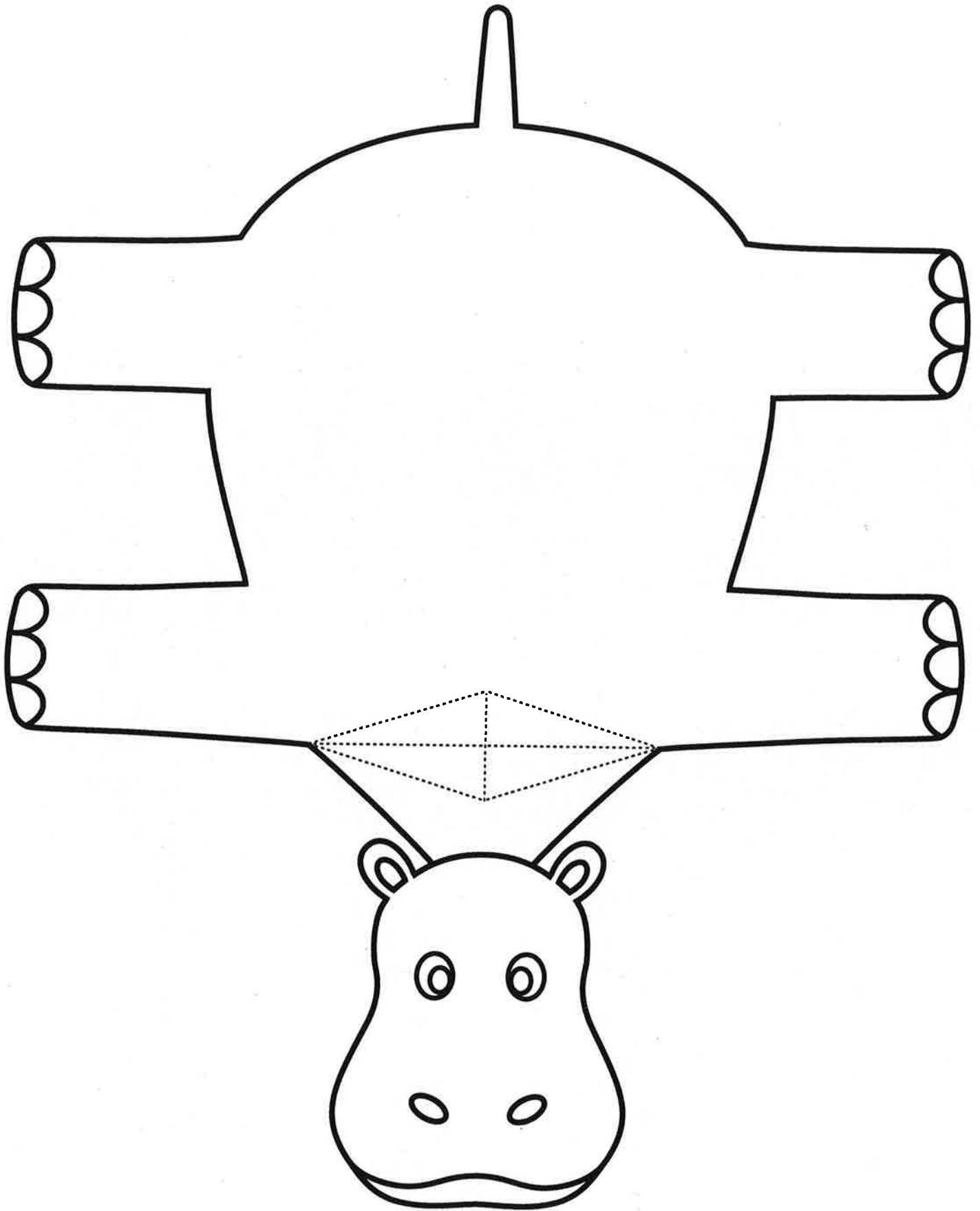


TIGER
