The Topic Papers are being developed by a Forest Service inter-disciplinary team addressing many of the Forest issues important to residents and businesses of the County, including natural resources, system drivers and stressors, social/cultural/economic conditions, scenic resources, mineral resources, land status ownership and use, access, multiple uses, and many others.

In order to best represent the interests of the County, it is important for the Board of Supervisors to gather the public's input on the Topic Papers as these topics relate to Inyo County residents and businesses, particularly those addressing multiple uses, biological resources, access, infrastructure and services, and socioeconomics.
