# County of Inyo Board of Supervisors

## SPECIAL MEETING 9:00 a.m.

### April 22, 2010

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Inyo, State of California, met in special session at the hour of 9:00 a.m., on Thursday, April 22, 2010, in the Board of Supervisors Room, County Administrative Center, Independence, with the following Supervisors present: Chairperson Richard Cervantes presiding, Beverly Brown, and Marty Fortney at the Independence location, Supervisor Arcularius at the RCRC location in Sacramento and with Supervisor Cash absent. Supervisor Cervantes provided the Invocation, and Supervisor Brown led the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Public Comment      The Chairperson announced the public comment period noting that the public is invited to address their remarks on this subject to the Board of Supervisors, and the public will not be able to participate in the actual conference call. A representative of the Bishop Paiute Tribe, and Susan Patton of Cartago, addressed the Board to support the Board's participation in this process.

Conference Call      The Chairperson announced that the Board would be participating in a conference call, with Mr. Randy Moore, Regional Forester, on the development of the U.S. Forest Service Land Management Planning Rule. The Chairperson noted that he, and Supervisors Brown and Fortney were participating from the Board's Chamber in Independence, that Supervisor Arcularius would be participating from the Regional Council of Rural Counties Offices at 1215 K. Street, Suite 1650, Sacramento, California, and that Supervisor Cash was in Sacramento for the CSAC Board Meeting and because of a conflict in schedules would not be participating. The County Administrator reviewed some of the items the Board wanted to talk about with Mr. Moore. At 9:30 a.m. the Board connected to the conference call to participate in the meeting. The conference call concluded at 11:05 a.m., with the Regional Forester thanking those who had participated. Supervisor Arcularius signed off.
