Description of Project: The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power owns and operates the Independence Wastewater Treatment Plant and sewer collection system. The current sewer User Service Charges were established in 1975, a new sewer User Service Charge fee structure is being proposed to increase the single family residential rate from \$3.50 per month to \$21 a month. Other customer classes will also face increased rates. Five annual step increases are being proposed.


