Project Description:

The Deep Rose project is an exploratory well drilling project whose purpose is to locate and verify suspected geothermal resources within Section 16, northeast of the intersection of U.S. Highway 395 and Coso Junction Road. The project proposes no production of geothermal power at this point – it is limited to the drilling of up to four exploratory wells only.

Although the California Department of Conservation-State Division of Oil, Gas & Geothermal Resources (DOGGR) is acting as the lead agency for the project and prepared the CEQA for the project (SCH #205121125), two Conditional Use Permits (CUPs) are required from the County: one, for water transfer under Chapter 18.77 of Inyo County Code (“Water Transfer Ordinance”), as the project will need up to 50 acre feet of water to support drilling activities and dust suppression on access roads. The second CUP is for the overall exploratory geothermal drilling of the project, which Title 19 of Inyo County Code (“Geothermal Resource Development”) provides for. The property is designated State & Federal Lands (SFL) under the Inyo County General Plan, and zoned Open Space, 40-acre minimum (OS-40) under the Inyo County Zoning Ordinance.
