

PROJECT LOCATION: The location of the test plot is near the shoreline of Owens Lake, bounded by State Route 136 to the north and east, State Route 190 to the south, and US Highway 395 to the West, in the County of Inyo, State of California.

DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT:

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) is investigating the efficacy of several soil stabilizer products on Owens Lake. The purpose of this pilot test is to evaluate the relative performance of the products, and to assess their potential to reduce the emissions of particulate matter with aerodynamic diameter of less than 10 microns in diameter (PM₁₀) from Owens Lake by stabilizing surface areas.
