

Let's Clear the Air



Inyo County is seeking proposals for community projects that will reduce particulate pollution in the Owens Valley Planning Area from Tinemaha Reservoir south to Haiwee Reservoir (see online map). Under the Clean Air Projects Program (CAPP II), up to \$1,260,000 is available to fund projects that directly or indirectly reduce air pollution emissions.
