- The photo must be in JPEG, JPG, or PNG format.
- The photo must have a resolution of at least 1920x1080 pixels.
- The photo must be received before February 24, 2023 and submitted to mtorres@inyocounty.us.
- If the photo(s) include people other than the individual making the submission, the photo(s) must be authorized by any and all individuals in the photo.
- By submitting a photo, you grant Inyo County all rights, including the use of and distribution of the photo, in all formats.
- Inyo County retains unrestricted rights to alter, distribute, reproduce, and use any submittals.
- Any individual making a photo submission agrees to not pursue copyright or other legal protection for the submitted photo(s) and to allow the photo(s) in original or altered format to be freely available to the general public.

Submissions must be sent via email to mtorres@inyocounty.us, along with a signed Publicity Release/Permission to Reprint form (required for all submissions) and signed Model Release (if needed). The subject of the email should be "Ready Inyo Photos – [YOUR NAME]."
